

ORDINANCE NO. 15-88

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING WITHIN THE  
VILLAGE OF FELICITY, ESTABLISHING PENALTIES  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is necessary to immediately regulate the parking of motor vehicles on S.R. 133 within the Village in order to preserve the Health, Safety and Welfare of the citizens of the Village of Felicity.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Felicity that:

- (1) It shall be illegal for any operator, owner or custodian of any motor vehicle to park on the street right-of-way of S.R. 133 within the Village of Felicity for more than twenty-four (24) consecutive hours.
- (2) A violation of this ordinance shall be a minor misdemeanor and punishable by a fine of up to one hundred dollars (\$100.00).
- (3) This ordinance is deemed an emergency and shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
