

ORDINANCE NO. 254

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Felicity, Clermont County, State of Ohio, at least three-fourths of all of the members elected to said Council concurring, that:

SECTION I

The Council finds that an emergency exists and that it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety of the Village of Felicity that this ordinance go into immediate effect.

SECTION II

Pursuant to the authority contained in Section 715.23, R.C., it is a misdemeanor punishable as hereinafter provided for any person, firm or corporation which is the owner of, or has charge of, cattle, horses, swine, sheep, goats, geese, chickens or any other fowl or animal to permit or suffer such animals to run at large within the Village of Felicity, Ohio.

SECTION III

No person, firm or corporation shall cause, permit or suffer any of the animals mentioned in the foregoing Section to be herded, kept or detained for the purpose of raising on any premises within the Village of Felicity, Ohio.

SECTION IV

The running at large of any animal mentioned in this Ordinance is *prima facie* evidence that it is running at large in violation of this Ordinance and the owner, harborer or person having charge of any such animal shall upon conviction of a violation of this Ordinance be fined not less than one nor more than five dollars for each day which any such animal is suffered or permitted so to run at large within the Village of Felicity, Ohio.

SECTION V

There being no newspaper printed in the Village of Felicity, Ohio, publication of this Ordinance shall be made by posting copies hereof in five of

the most public places in the Village of Felicity, Ohio, to-wit:
