AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PLACEMENT OF MAIL BOXES IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Felicity that:

WHEREAS, Council wishes to regulate the placement of mail boxes within the Village, and,

WHEREAS, Council desires to prevent the placement of mail boxes on or above the public right of way, so as to interfere with pedestrian or vehicular traffic, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Felicity, at least a majority of its members concurring:

Section 1. That no person shall place a mailbox, paper holder, or other receptacle in or above the public right of way within the Village of Felicity.

Section 2. Whoever is found in violation of this ordinance, shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor. Each 24 hour day shall be considered a separate and distinct offense under this ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that it directly affects the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Felicity and shall be effective January 1, 2008.
