Ordinance No. 359-07 Passed October 4, 2007

AN ORDINANCE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF FELICITY REQUIRING FENCING AROUND DUMPSTERS, CREATING PENALTIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is necessary to enclose dumpsters within the Village of Felicity in order to preserve the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Felicity,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that:


SECTION I

All dumpsters within the Village of Felicity shall be enclosed on four sides with a fence at least six feet in height. The fence shall be of a material that will not allow the dumpster to be seen from outside the enclosed area.


SECTION II

A violation of this Ordinance shall be a minor misdemeanor and shall be punishable with a fine of up to \$100 per day. The term dumpster as used in this ordinance does not include containers intended to be used primarily for receiving recyclable material.


This Ordinance is deemed an emergency for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Felicity, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
