

ORDINANCE BY THE VILLAGE OF FELICITY MAKING  
EXCESSIVE ACCELERATION ILLEGAL, PROVIDING  
PENALTIES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Felicity needs to pass legislation to control excessive acceleration within the Village limits to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Felicity.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT:

SECTION I It shall be illegal for anyone operating a motor vehicle within the Village of Felicity to knowingly or recklessly cause that vehicle to accelerate in an excessive manner.

SECTION II The term excessive is defined for purposes of this Ordinance to mean acceleration at a rate that creates a risk of harm to persons or property.

SECTION III Violations of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be a minor misdemeanor and be punishable with a maximum \$100.00 fine per violation.

SECTION IV This Ordinance is deemed an emergency and shall take effect at the earliest time allowable by law.
